American Eagle Airlines to Increase Service to Dallas-Fort Worth International (DFW) from Jackson-Evers International (JEIA)

American Eagle, American Airlines regional airline affiliate, will be adding additional service to Dallas-Ft. Worth International Airport beginning April 7, 2009.

Beginning April 7, 2009, passengers will be able to choose from any of nine flights per day (Sunday – Friday) between JEIA and DFW airports when American Eagle Airlines adds another 50 seat Embraer regional jet (ERJ) to the fleet servicing JEIA. American Eagle will continue to operate seven flights a day on Saturdays. “We are pleased to share in the success of our business partner. This increase in service to our customers in the Jackson market indicates that we are doing our job in supporting the airlines and our customers who fly by keeping our operations cost effective and attractive to the airlines” stated Dirk B. Vanderleest, CEO of the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority.

This new flight will depart DFW daily at 6:45 A.M, arriving in Jackson at 8:00 A.M., and return to Dallas at 8:25 A.M. for an arrival at DFW each morning at 9:55 A.M.
