US Airways Introducing New Larger Aircraft Service to Jackson-Evers International (JEIA)



US Airways will be up-gauging service with new 70 - seat CRJ's beginning May 9, 2009. US Airways plans to introduce new aircraft to the fleet mix at JEIA with the introduction of Canadair CRJ-700 jets. "When airlines up-gauge equipment they know they need to offer additional seats to service a market. We are pleased to share in the success of our business partner. This increase in service to our customers in the Jackson market indicates that we are doing our job in supporting the airlines and our customers who fly by keeping our operations cost effective and attractive to the airlines" stated Dirk B. Vanderleest, CEO of the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority. These new jets will operate between JEIA and Charlotte-Douglas International (CTL) daily at 6:00 A.M. and again at 5:56 P.M. In order to accommodate more passengers per flight, the new larger aircraft, and offer jet bridge service to their customers, US Airways will also be relocating to Gate # 16 on the West Concourse at JEIA, May 3, 2009.
